

## **PREMIUM GOLF IN BUENOS AIRES, BARILOCHE AND SAN MARTIN DE LOS ANDES ITINERARY**

### **DAY 1**

**Arrival and meeting at the airport by Patagonia Golf staff and transfer to Hotel.**

### **DAY 2**

**Breakfast and private city tour with an English speaking guide.**

Buenos Aires is a charming city with a strong influence of most of the main European cities. Beautiful walks, avenues, parks, monumental buildings, cafes, museums and churches gathered in 26 districts, each with its own distinct personality, gives it a truly cosmopolitan air. The northern quarter resembles the most elegant areas of Paris, May Avenue and its innumerable cafes houses revives the flavour of Madrid's Gran Via, the shady Belgrano streets recall the distinguished Londoners suburb, Naples seem to be present in the noisy and coloured La Boca quarter. pion, won here twice, and is an honorary member.

**In the afternoon, transfer to San Andrés GC.**

Is the oldest golf club in Argentina. The course was built in 1892, at 1894 the first official golf match took place here. The club is named after The Royal & Ancient Golf Club of St. Andrew's. It is no coincidence that in time the neighbour and the railway station, created initially for club members to come by train, took the name of San Andrés.

It is a par 72 for Men and 73 for Ladies, with a maximum 6772 yards length. San Andres Golf Club hosted the "Abierto de la Republica" 21 times (more than any other club). Roberto De Vincenzo, the 1967 British Open Champion, won here twice, and is an honorary member.

### **DAY 3**

**Breakfast and transfer to Pilar Golf.**

On 2006 and 2011 this course hosted the Argentine Open.

This American style 7221 yards long field will test your power distance as well of your short game on its 18 championship holes built on more than 247 acres, that were inaugurated in 1993 plus an additional 9-hole course was opened recently. It also has a quite impressive, luxurious and large club-house with several services for golfers.

**In the evening Optional Tango Show with dinner at Esquina Carlos Gardel.**

This dance today represents our country at international events. Its sensuality has traveled the world over in the voices of famous singers. From its origin in the marginal neighborhood of La Boca at the beginning of the twentieth century, Tango has come a long way and today is danced in the finest dancehalls in Buenos Aires and the world: a dance that that has its origins in brothels became a myth and is today a symbol of the city and country.

### **DAY 4**

**Breakfast and transfer to Olivos GC.**

It's considered the best golf course in Argentina, it is ranked 71st on the Golf Digest's "best golf courses outside US."

The course currently has 27 holes and it's considered one of the best in South America for its beauty, tight fairways and sloppy greens. Olivos Golf has been host of international tournaments such as the Masters -first in South America- the "Abierto de la Republica", the "copa los Andes", among others. It has also been played by the best European and American players. This course has hosted the Golf World Cup on 2010.

## DAY 5

### **Breakfast and transfer to national airport. Flight to Bariloche.**

Undoubtedly PATAGONIA suggests the most amazing latitudes of the globe. At the southernmost tips of continental Argentina, the Andean mountain Range shows a variety of natural beauties that will surprise tourist, among which glaciers, wonderful forest and lakes of glacier origin can be enjoyed

In this place the granite peaks and mystical forests of the Andes in western Patagonia cradle one of the world's most beautiful courses –They say you can hear the silence).

Arrival in the Argentine Patagonia area (Bariloche) and transfer to Hotel.

## DAY 6

### **Breakfast and golf in the Liao Liao GC.**

With a superb location, surrounded by deep-blue lakes, snow-covered mountains and natural forests, the golf course belongs to the Liao - Liao Hotel & Resort; it has asymmetric fairways, imposing green and bunkers perfectly integrated to the environment.

Liao-liao design cross quite a few times the “Nahuel Huapi Lake” and the 18th hole is one of the two holes in argentina that are among the best 500 hundred In the world. It is a 180 par 3 in which you'll need to fly tee-to-green otherwise you will end up “snorkeling” on the “Nahuel Huapi” Lake.

## DAY 7

### **Breakfast and golf in the amazing Arelauquen GC.**

This amazing 18-hole course 6,693-yard and Par-72 golf course is located on the northwestern shore of Lake Gutiérrez. It is crossed by the Longochinoco Creek, which makes up a central valley in the shape of a horse-shoe opening towards the lake. Immersed in a setting where the air is pure, surrounded by mountains, lakes of crystal-clear waters, unique vegetation and the highest level infrastructure necessary for golfers.

### **After Golf Optional Excursion & Dinner at The Refugio.**

The Arelauquen Refugio (mountain shelter) is situated on the summit of Cerro Otto, so you can enjoy our gastronomic delights whilst experiencing the deep silence of the forest all around. The breathtaking panoramic view of the Andean cordillera and lakes Nahuel Huapi, Gutiérrez and Moreno, plus the coziness of our restaurant set the scene for truly magical moments.

This amazing mountain top restaurant rests on a natural viewpoint at 1300m. The restaurant trip involves an unforgettable 4x4 adventure, unique in Patagonia

## DAY 8

### **Breakfast in Bariloche and departure by land to the north Patagonia area.**

Making the 7 lakes route in a private van (arriving 3 hours later, crossing mountains, lakes and rivers) in San Martín de los Andes.

This Village is located on the shores of Lake Lácar, the city is located in a natural basin, protecting it from the wind. Its geographical location is of singular beauty, almost hidden in a sumptuous amphitheater in the mountains that preserves the fertility of its lake and forest environment.

### DAY 9

#### **Breakfast and Golf in Chapelco GC, the first Jack Nicklaus and Jack Nicklaus II co-designed golf course in South America.**

One of the Nicklaus' design philosophies is to avoid disrupting the natural setting as much as possible. They believe it is very important to preserve the natural features of the land and not go against what Mother Nature has created, thereby letting the surroundings shape the golf holes to fit the existing terrain. The 18 - hole Chapelco course was designed to enhance the unparalleled scenic beauty on which is placed.

#### **In the afternoon optional half Fly-Fishing day to the Chimehuin river.**

The Chimehuin is a moderate grade freestone river that can be compared in size to the Madison or Yellowstone Rivers. The Chimehuin has an amazing variety of waters, most allowing fly fishermen to easily wade the cobblestone riverbed while sight fishing for wild Rainbow and Brown Trout averaging 16 - 20 inches with fish in the 21 - 24 inch range being common. While streamers and nymphs are effective, the Fly Fishing Andes guides' passion is catching trout on dry flies.

### DAY 10

#### **Breakfast and transfer to national airport. Flight to Buenos Aires. Arrival and transfer to the Hotel. Last night in Argentina.**

### DAY 11

#### **Breakfast and transfer to International Airport.**
