DAY 1

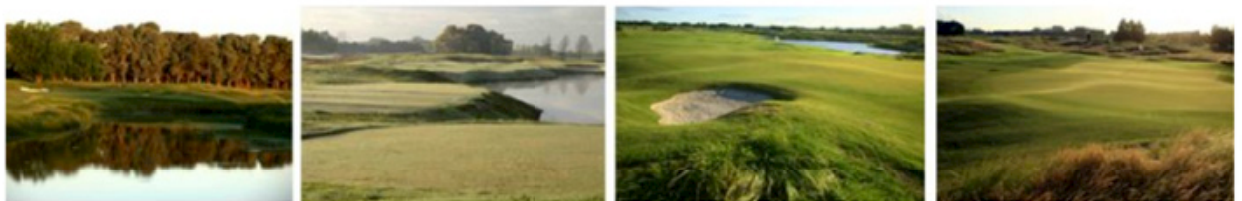
Arrival, meeting at the airport by **Patagonia Golf** and **transfer to the Hotel**, located in the best area of the city.



In the Afternoon Private city Tour. Buenos Aires is a charming city with a strong influence of most of the main European cities. Beautiful walks, avenues, parks, monumental buildings, cafes, museums and churches gathered in 26 districts, each with its own distinct personality, gives it a truly cosmopolitan air. DAY 2

Breakfast and transfer to **Pilara GC.**

DAY 3

Breakfast and transfer to the Jockey Club – Red Course (The Championship One)



Probably the most prestigious Golf Club in Argentina. Founded in 1880 Jockey club has 36 holes created by augusta national designer, Allister Mackenzie. Both courses (blue and red) will test your strategy skills amogn with your driving accuracy. Host of the most important tournaments, such as the “Abierto de la República”, the World Cup, the European Tour and the amateurs’ championships. The Jockey Club also proved its hardness with some of the best golfers in history such as Arnold Palmer, Sam Snead, Tom Watson, Gary Player, Craig Stadler, Byron Nelson, Sergio Garcia and many others. In 2005 Golf digest ranked The Jockey Club Red Course as one of the best 100 courses around the world.

DAY 4

Breakfast and day at leisure. Optional golf at **Buenos Aires GC**



This course is ranked 79th out of the “Best 100 Golf Courses Outside US” and top 2 in Buenos Aires, this course and it’s facilities will guarantee a great golf experience...that is of course if you are not afraid to get a little wet in all of the water hazards that line the fairways.” In its short 10 years of life, it has had the opportunity to be the host of the World Cup EMC2, in December of 2000. At that time, many of the best golfers in the world took part of the event, including Tiger Woods and David Duval.

In the evening **Optional Tango Show with dinner**

This dance today represents our country at international events. Its sensuality has traveled the world over in the voices of famous singers. From its origin in the marginal neighborhood of La Boca at the beginning of the twentieth century, Tango has come a long way and today is danced in the finest dancehalls in Buenos Aires and the world: a dance that that has its origins in brothels became a myth and is today a symbol of the city and country.

DAY 5

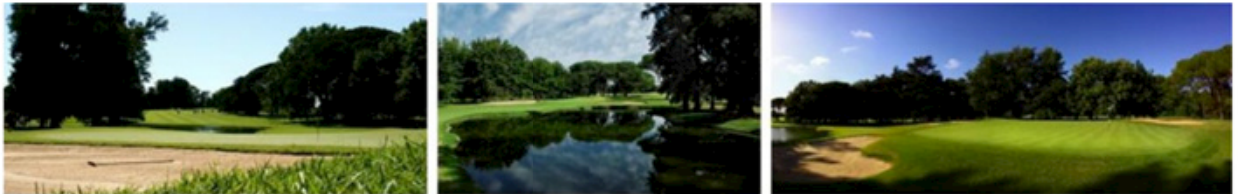
Breakfast and transfer to **San Andres Golf**.



Is the oldest golf club in Argentina. The course was built in 1892, at 1894 the first official golf match took place here. The club is named after The Royal & Ancient Golf Club of St. Andrew's. The 18 holes golf course was designed by Scottish Pro Mr. Mungo Park. It is a par 72 for Men and 73 for Ladies, with a maximum 6772 yards length. San Andres Golf Club hosted the "Abierto de la Republica" 21 times (more than any other club). Roberto De Vincenzo, the 1967 British Open Champion, won here twice, and is an honorary member.

DAY 6

Breakfast and transfer to the **Olivos GC**.



It's considered the best golf course in Argentina, it is ranked 71st on the Golf Digest's "best golf courses outside US.". The course currently has 27 holes and it's considered one of the best in South America for its beauty, tight fairways and floppy greens. Olivos Golf has been host of international tournaments such as the Masters -first in South America- the "Abierto de la Republica", the "copa los Andes", among others. It has also been played by the best European and American players.

This course has hosted the Golf World Cup on 2010.

DAY 7

Breakfast and transfer to the **International Airport**.
