DAY 1: Meet and greet at the International Airport by one of our guides. Transfer to your hotel. In the afternoon private city tour. Buenos Aires is a charming city with a strong influence of most of the main European cities.

Olivos: It's considered the best golf course in Argentina and ranked 71st on the Golf Digest as "best golf courses outside US.". This course hosted the Amateur Golf World Cup on 2010.

San Andres: Is the oldest golf club in Argentina. This Parkland design course, par 72 and 6772

yards length was built in 1892. San Andres Golf Club hosted the "Abierto de la Republica" 21 times.

Pilar: This course hosted the 2006 and 2011 Argentine Masters and the Latinamerican Amateur Championship, an event sponsored by the The Masters Tournament, The R&A and the United States Golf Association.

DAY 5 to 7: Breakfast and Flight to The Malbec Wine Area - Mendoza. During the Stay in the winecountry you will enjoy private eno-experiences with a chance to know, taste, and enjoy the finest Wines in Mendoza, selected by Robert Parker (all of them more than 90 points) and play 2 rounds of golf in

Club de Campo Golf: a championship 18 holes with a wonderful scenery, full of trees and different kinds of pine trees, creating an amazing contrast with the green course and the Andes range.

Tupungato Winelands GC: The best course of Mendoza is located in one of the most magnificent valleys of Mendoza, at the foot of the Andes Mountain Range and with the Cordón del Plata and the Tupungato Hill as framework, stretches one of the most prestigious wine regions in Argentina:

The Uco Valley.
